

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION 2019

- 1. The Calcot-Seitz Scholarship has been established for promising young students from Arizona, California, New Mexico, and Texas who plan to attend a college or are attending a college offering at least a FOUR-YEAR DEGREE in Agriculture.
- 2. To be considered, the student must be from a cotton-producing area of California, Arizona, New Mexico, or Texas
- 3. To be considered, the student must be enrolled as a full-time student in a four-year college and have a major in the field of Agriculture. **Students planning on becoming veterinarians are not eligible.**
- 4. Scholastic achievement will be a criteria for selection, and a general guideline will be a 3.0 grade point average for high school graduates and college students. Committee must receive both high school and all college transcripts. We suggest you obtain official transcripts sealed by the school and enclose them with your completed application.
- 5. **Please be sure that all transcripts have the G.P.A. on them.** Applicants must request that transcripts from all high schools and colleges attended be sent to:

- Applicants must complete the entire application form along with having three recommendations from non-relatives. Two of the recommendations must come from individuals outside the teaching profession. (Recommendations must be postmarked by the deadline date of March 31, 2019. These recommendations may be faxed by the deadline to Calcot-Seitz, Attn. Marci S. Cunningham, 661-861-9870. Applications should be typed or computer generated by the applicant. Please enclose one personal photograph with your application.
- 7. All documents should be sent to the Scholarship Committee at the above address.
- 8. Recipients of the Calcot-Seitz Scholarship will be selected based on the student's application, recommendations, and an oral interview with the Scholarship Committee.
- 9. Leadership qualities such as 4-H, FFA, church, clubs, student government and civic organizations participation will be a consideration.
- Personality, ability to communicate, and self control are considerations. A personal interview will be held for finalists.
- 11. Financial need is a criteria.
- 12. Strong consideration will be given to applicants in the cotton growing areas of California, Arizona, New Mexico, and Texas, whom the Committee believes will have an excellent chance of returning to a vocation in production agriculture, processing or marketing of agricultural products, or agricultural education.
- 13. Applications from previous award winners will not be accepted.
- 14. It is the responsibility of the applicant to assure that all information arrives by the deadline. **DO NOT** assume that all information has arrived! **Please note: It is recommended that applicant's references be contacted and reminded of the deadline.**
- 15. Application deadline is March 31, 2019. Applications must be postmarked by this date to qualify. All recommendations must also arrive or be postmarked by this date in order to qualify. NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE. Please select your references carefully so they understand the deadline.
